

WRITING MINOR

All writing courses in the minor should be taken in the Department of Writing and taken for a grade to count toward the minor. Writing courses at the 200-level or above must be completed with a 'C' or better.

Academic Writing I (WRTG 10600) and Ithaca College Seminars in Writing (ICSM 108xx, 118xx) do not count toward the writing minor.

Up to 8 credits in the writing minor may overlap with a student's writing requirements in a major.

Requirements

WRTG 1xxx	Select one course at the 100-level ¹	4
WRTG 2xxx	Select two courses at the 200-level with attribute designation WRCW, WRPW, or WRRRC. The two courses can have the same or different attribute designations.	8
WRTG 3xxx	Select two courses at the 300-level with attribute designation WRCW, WRPW, or WRRRC. The two courses can have the same or different attribute designations.	8

Additional Requirements for the Minor

1. All writing courses must be taken for a grade to count toward the minor. Writing courses at the 200-level or above must be completed with a C or better.
2. Up to 8 credits in the writing minor may overlap with a student's writing requirements in a major.
